This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is hereby solemnized between Women's College, Calcutta, P- 29, Kshirode VidyaVinode Avenue, Baghbazar, Kolkata, West Bengal -700003 represented by Teacher-in-Charge, Smt. Swati Sengupta and Basirhat College, 24 PGS North, West Bengal-743412 represented by Principal Dr. Ashoke Kumar Mondal fostering collaborative academic growth and development, as envisaged by UGC and NAAC for a period of 5 years w.e.f. 07.02.2022.

Scope:

The signing of this Memorandum of Understanding is evidence that the organisations want to investigate the prospect of working together in a variety of capacities, including the following:

a) The sharing of information and knowledge.

b) The reciprocal visitation of teaching staff and the exchange of students between various undergraduate programmes in the sciences and the humanities.

- c) Faculty exchange will also be given a special priority between the two organisations as part of this collaborative effort.
- d) The development of cooperative research activities; in the course of implementing the items linked to research, the Research Scholars and Research Guides of both institutions will adhere to the norms and regulations of the Government and the affiliating University as and when they are appropriate.
- e) To hold joint symposia and seminars in the country of India. Participants from both of these colleges, as well as colleges in the surrounding area, including those belonging to other universities, will be invited to attend the symposia, training programmes, and seminars that will be designed and organised jointly by Basirhat College and Women's College, Calcutta.
- f) Offer the students the opportunity to participate in internships.

Departments:

The above collaboration will include all the available Departments, Faculties of both Basirhat College and Women's College, Calcutta.

Terms of MoU:

Prior to the beginning of each individual action that is to be carried out in accordance with this agreement; the terms of the Understanding that will govern that activity will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties. These kinds of agreements will provide complete consideration to problems pertaining to quality assurance and financial concerns, and they may be subject to legal contracts depending on what the parties involved decide.

This Memorandum of Understanding will remain in effect for a period of five years, after which time it may be renewed if both parties agree to the terms and conditions of the renewal. Both the Basirhat College and the Women's College, Calcutta will periodically and in a manner that is mutually agreed upon review the Memorandum of Understanding together.
